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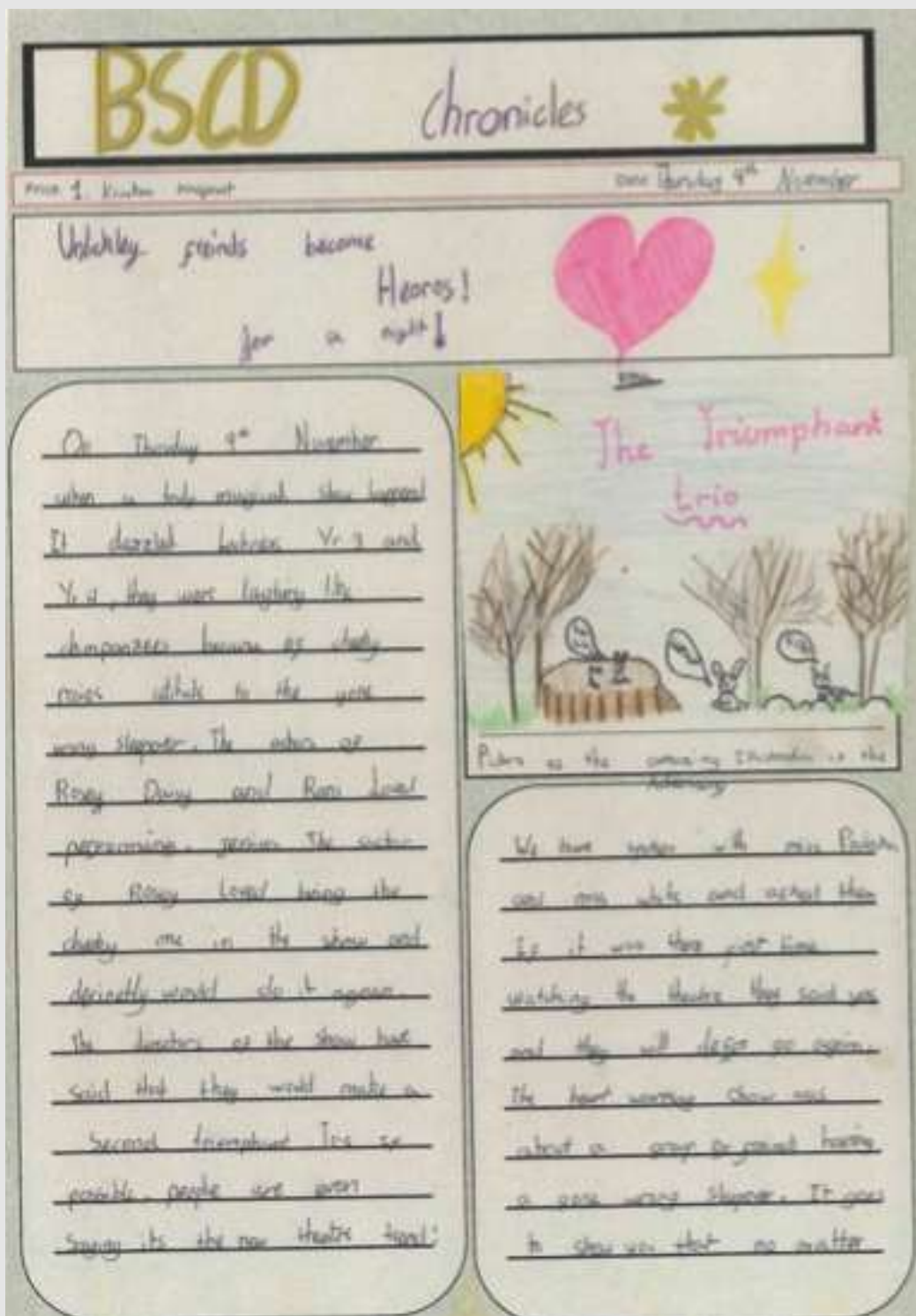

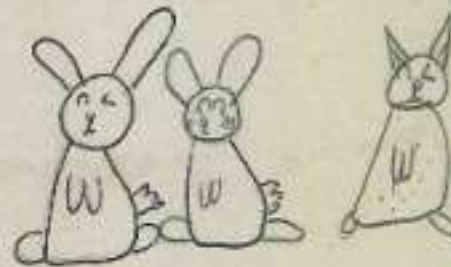

Every day, pre-nursery children develop their social skills by working with one another on sharing. This is evident in their cooperative play, such as role-play or construction. Children are working on both their gross and fine motor skills.

They enjoy moving in numerous ways, such as running, jumping, balancing on blocks, walking on buckets and rolling tapes. Children nurture their love for books by listening to and reacting to stories every day.

A closer look: NURSERY



In Nursery, we learn social skills, the ability to communicate and interact with others. Social skills are related to self-awareness, self-regulation and empathy. We also work on routines. Every morning, we hang up our jackets, put away our bottles and do our circle time. We read a lot of stories, learn to count to 10, do crafts, play, and have a great time!

A closer look: RECEPTION

Reception are learning wonderful things like counting up to ten and backwards. They are experimenting with what materials float and why. They are also working very hard at remembering and using their new-found phonics to write their letters to Santa.

A closer look: YEAR 1

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In literacy, Year 1 is learning about adjectives like "tall", "short", "old" and "thin" to make their sentences more descriptive. In maths, they are comparing numbers using the "greater than", "less than" and "equal" signs.

They are also practicing their additions and subtractions. This term's topic is: All types of Dinosaurs! Omnivors, herbivores, carnivores..

A closer look: Year 2

In literacy in Year 2, they are learning how to formulate questions; e.g., How old are you? What is your name? What's your favourite colour? Do you like dogs? In maths, they are doing number bonds and fact families. In topic, they are studying time lines and

fossils. They are also singing the school song because it is a fun way to learn our school's values, which are: kindness, fitness, responsibility, respect, creativity and personal best. The Year 2s are going on a trip to take photos next month.

A closer look: YEAR 3

This year, there are two Year 3 classes. The teacher for one class is Ms Neal and in the other class the teacher is Ms Houlker. In Year 3, the kids are learning about rainforests in topic, and in literacy and they are looking at letters and stories about the rainforest. In maths, they are studying place value, adding and subtracting. In science, they are looking at parts of a plant in detail and how they grow.



A closer look: YEAR 4

This year there are two Year 4 classes. One class is Ms Nelson's while the other one is Ms White's. In Year 4, the kids are learning about rainforests in topic; how to use persuasive language in literacy; in maths, they are learning about how to subtract with more than one digit; and in science they are looking at animal adaptation in rainforests. The kids in *whole class reading* are reading a comic book called *El Deafo*..



A closer look: YEAR 5

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In year 5, they have been working on their topic leisure and entertainment. In maths, they are working on addition and subtraction and are always trying to use mental strategies. In science, they are studying space. They are doing some fruit experiments to see the distance from one planet to the next, and making an independent video about day and night. They also use scientific words like "orbit" and "rotate". Soon, they will be looking at the movement of the moon.



A closer look: YEAR 6

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In year 6, they have been doing fractions in maths (adding fractions and subtracting them) and they have learnt about L.C.M, meaning the lowest common multiple. In science, they are looking into light. The pupils are doing

presentations on some topics they have chosen and they are doing some stop-motion film-making. These are fascinating videos with photos that are joined together, which requires a lot of work because of the countless number of photos involved in the process. The final product has been shown to the class.

A closer look: YEAR 7

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Year 7 is the first year of Key Stage 3, which is already Secondary and is the class I am in. Year 7 is a sensible class; although they misbehave a bit, they are still a good class. There are 18 pupils in Year 7.

Uns 4.000 usuaris únics diaris; uns 30.000 a la setmana i més de 100.000 al mes. Estem contents perquè cada dia ens visiten més persones. Tenim unes 2.000 activitats publicades a la web. També hi ha molta gent que ens segueix a través d'Instagram, allà som 13,7 mil.

Quins són els continguts més visitats?

En aquesta època la gent busca activitats nadalenques, gimcanes de Tions, fires, ect. Però durant l'any, el contingut més visitat són les excursions! Excursions a boscos encantats, a camins de bruixes, a coves, a ponts penjants.... I també llocs singulars per fer un pícnic.

Sou més de mar o de muntanya?

De muntanya! Alguna cosa té la natura que ens transforma... Ens relaxa, ens permet respirar, deixar-nos anar, jugar... ens agrada travessar rius, passar per damunt de ponts penjants, trepar pels arbres i fer cabanyes amb els troncs que ens trobem pel camí.

Quina excursió em recomaneu a Tarragona?

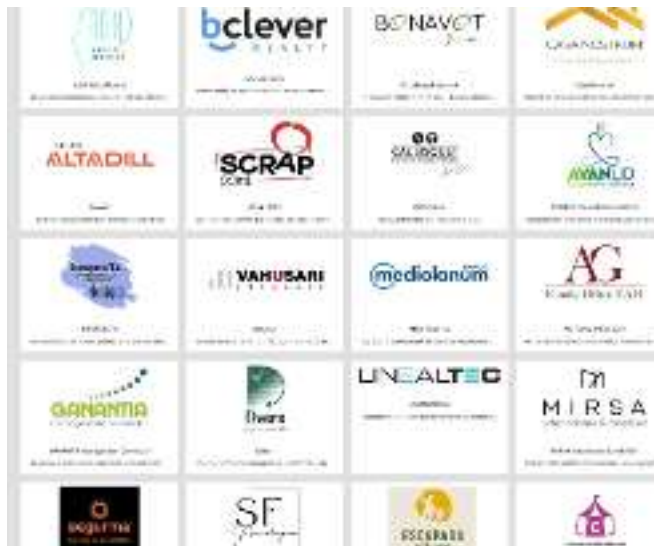
